Daily decisions will be made on frost delays and closings, as well as temporary greens, tees, and practice facilities. All facilities are closed on Mondays.

Golf Policies

PRACTICE FACILITIES

The practice facilities are available to members for use Tuesday through Sunday. Balls at the practice facilities are available at no additional charge. Guests may use the practice facilities, including the putting and chipping greens, immediately before and after a round with a member of Steel Club. All membership restrictions outlined in the membership information packet apply.

DRESS CODE

Those desiring to wear shorts may wear dress or Bermuda-style shorts. No cargo, tennis apparel, jeans, jean-style pants, cut-offs, or tank tops are permitted. Men's shirts are required to be of the type specifically designed for golf (with collars or mock turtlenecks and sleeves). Ladies' sleeveless shirts must have a collar. Ladies' shirts without collars must have sleeves. Ladies may wear slacks, skirts, skorts, or shorts.

STARTING TIMES

Members are encouraged to reserve starting times in advance for play. Full golf and business members may reserve times fourteen days in advance. All other membership categories may reserve seven days in advance. Members may only book up to 3 starting times per day. All players listed as TBD will need to have player names 48 hours in advance, or those slots will open. Any members abusing this system are subject to suspension of tee times.

PACE OF PLAY

Members and their guests are expected to complete a round within at least four hours. The professional staff has the right to monitor the pace of play and reserves the right to ask groups to adjust their round to keep up with the pace.

Golf Services

LOCKERS

A locker for one person is included in annual dues. Day guest lockers are complimentary, subject to availability. Locker and club services for spouses are optional on a space-available basis. Additional fees may apply.

HANDICAP

A computerized GHIN handicap service for the primary member is available for an additional \$50 per year per person. Please make sure you post your scores following each round. The professional staff has the right to post penalty scores for players who regularly fail to post.

STEEL MILL ATHLETIC CENTER

Five hitting stations, a large putting green, and a TrackMan Golf Simulator with over 120 courses and a driving range keep your game sharp. Bar seating and two flat-screen TVs make the Mill a perfect place for recreation and practice. Five hitting stations are used on a first-come, first-serve basis. The simulator may be booked through the member website/app for \$20 per hour.

CLUB FITTING & REPAIR

The professional staff has partnered with golf manufacturers to provide members with the highest quality, custom-fit golf equipment. Our professional staff has been trained to determine which set of clubs will be best for your enjoyment of the game. Both the scratch player and occasional golfer will benefit greatly from clubs designed specifically for them and will enjoy golf even more. All club fittings are done using TrackMan Technology. Repair services include regripping, reshafting, and ferrule replacement.

HANDICAP QUALIFICATIONS

Players are strongly encouraged to have a handicap to participate in events. Players without a verifiable handicap will be marked as a scratch golfer on the day of play. Handicaps from GHIN, 18 Birdies, and The Grint are acceptable.

ACCESS & CART FEES

All applicable access fees will be charged based on membership type. Cart fees will be charged unless the member opts into a yearlong cart package. **This is applicable to every tournament/league.**

Breakdown by membership type per 18-hole round

- Full Golf with an unlimited cart package: additional \$0.00 per round
- Full Golf without an unlimited cart package: additional \$35.00 cart fee per round
- Businesses 1-5: additional \$0.00 per round, utilizing a round for each round
- Limited Family: additional \$35.00 cart fee, \$42.00 access fee, and utilizing a round for each round
- After 2 PM with an unlimited cart package: additional \$42.00 access fee for play prior to 2:00 pm for each round
- After 2 PM without an unlimited cart package: additional \$35.00 cart fee and \$42.00 access fee for play prior to 2:00 pm for each round

MEN & LADIES STEEL CLUB “POINTS LIST” EARNINGS

Format: Two best balls of four

Members pair themselves

Gross and net divisions, and flights will be created based on the field size

Prizes awarded for gross and net divisions by USGA handicap (85%)

BEAT THE PRO 1-2-3 WALTZ

Date: Sunday, June 14th

Start: Tee times starting at 8:00 am

Format: Four-person member team versus team of pros

1 ball counts on hole 1, best 2 balls count on hole 2, best 3 balls count on hole 3, and repeat for 18 holes

USGA Handicap (85%)

Members pair themselves

Entry Fee: \$20/player

US OPEN WITH TOUR PRO

Date: Saturday, June 20th

Start: Players will make their own tee times and must add a note to their tee time to participate

Golf shop staff will be on the first tee, confirming participation and handing out scorecards

Format: Players will randomly select a tour player ranked 1-20 playing on Saturday in the US Open

Your score (USGA Handicap (95%)) plus the tour player's score on Saturday is the total team score

Tour players who teed off prior to the player's tee time are ineligible for partner selection

MEN'S MEMBER-GUEST INVITATIONAL

Date: Thursday - Saturday, June 25th - 27th

Start: Thursday: 10:45 am lunch, 12:00 pm shotgun (practice round), 6:30 pm dinner
