Steel Club's Winter Golf Policy (November through March) dictates that we make daily decisions regarding temporary greens and tees,

adjusting the practice facility setup, frost delays, or closing the golf course entirely. All facilities are closed on Mondays.

## Golf Policies

## PRACTICE FACILITIES

The practice facilities are available to members for use Tuesday through Sunday. Balls at the practice facilities are available at no additional charge. Guests may use the practice facilities, including the putting and chipping greens, immediately before and after a round with a member of Steel Club. All membership restrictions outlined in the membership information packet apply. In the case of business memberships, the practice facility privileges are extended only to the primary and designated members.

#### **DRESS CODE**

Those desiring to wear shorts may wear dress or Bermuda-style shorts. No tennis apparel, jeans, jean-style pants, cut-offs, or tank tops are permitted. Men's shirts are required to be of the type specifically designed for golf (with collars or mock turtlenecks and sleeves) and must always be worn tucked in with a belt. Ladies' sleeveless shirts must have a collar. Ladies' shirts without collars must have sleeves. Ladies may wear slacks, skirts, skorts, or shorts.

## STARTING TIMES

Members are encouraged to reserve starting times in advance for play. Reservations may be made by the member or member's spouse. For business members, starting times may be made by primary or designated members. Full golf and business members may reserve times fourteen days in advance. All other membership categories may book seven days in advance. Members may only book up to 3 starting times per day. All players listed as TBD will need to have player names 48 hours in advance or those slots will open. Any members abusing this system are subject to suspension of tee times.

#### PACE OF PLAY

It is the goal of the Club to have members and their guests complete a round within at least four hours. The professional staff reserves the right to monitor pace of play and reserves the right to ask groups to make adjustment to their round to keep up with pace.

## Golf Services

#### **LOCKERS**

A locker for one person is included in annual dues. Day lockers to accommodate guests will be assigned on a space available basis at no charge. Locker and club services for spouses are optional on a space-available basis. Additional fees may apply.

#### **HANDICAP**

A computerized GHIN handicap service for the primary member is available for an additional \$40 per year per person. Please make sure you post your scores following each round. The professional staff has the right to post penalty scores for players who regularly fail to post.

#### STEEL MILL ATHLETIC CENTER

Five hitting stations, a large putting green, and a TrackMan Golf Simulator with over 120 courses and a driving range keep your game sharp. Bar seating and two flat-screen TVs make the Mill a perfect place for recreation and practice. Five hitting stations are used on a first come, first serve basis. The simulator may be booked through the member website/app at \$20 per hour.

## **CLUB FITTING & REPAIR**

The professional staff has partnered with golf manufacturers to provide members with the highest quality, custom fit golf equipment. Our professional staff has been trained to determine which set of clubs will be best for your enjoyment of the game. Both the scratch player and occasional golfer will benefit greatly from clubs designed specifically for them and will enjoy golf even more. All club fittings are done using TrackMan Technology.

#### **PLAYING LESSON**

An on-course playing lesson is a great way for a student to learn game and course management as well as swing instruction. A playing lesson an open-ended time for the student to dictate to the instructor how the lesson will proceed. The student may want the instructor to play the round and be available to answer questions or the student may want the instructor to guide each shot, only demonstrating shots at the student's request. Either way, the playing lesson can be a great tool for the game development. The fee for a playing lesson is \$100 per hour on the golf course. An additional \$25 per player will be charged for extra students attending the playing lesson.
